LEARNER NOTES

Brisbane Seniors OnLine is a volunteer Association incorporated to help the over-50s in the Greater Brisbane area learn basic computer, email and internet skills.

Brisbane has been divided into areas called Hubs and each Hub has its own Coordinator. The Hub Coordinator is responsible for matching mentors with learners, developing group training venues and other activities relating to the Hub.
